**General Description:** Youth Camp Counselor that works with children ages 7-12.

**Dates:** May 19 – August 29, 2008 (start and end date could vary)

**Requirements:**

- Certification in CPR (Certification will be available at a staff training)

**Pay:** \$8.50 per hour for 40 hours per week (during camp weeks). Work-week is Monday – Friday.
