COURSE OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this course is to re-certify current CPR/AED Professionals

Once successfully completing this re-certification, candidates will be re-authorized to

- Respond in an emergency
- Ensure personal & bystander safety
- Gain access to the victim
- Get consent when providing care
- Determine whether any life-threatening conditions are present
- Provide needed care for the victim
- Summon more help when needed by activating the EM system
- Use techniques acquired from your training in the course

Perform

- Primary / Secondary assessment skills
- Rescue breathing (Adult/Child/Infant)
- 2 Person -Rescue breathing w/use of bag valve
- Obstructed Airway (Conscious & Unconscious - Adult/Child/Infant)
- One Rescuer CPR (Adult/Child/Infant)
- Two Rescuer CPR (Adult/Child/Infant)
- 1 & 2 Rescuer AED Administration

Once successfully completed this re-certification course, participants will receive an American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer & Health Care Provider Certification (2 year validation)
