WHAT TO BRING TO CLASS

Note taking material, pocket mask, comfortable clothing and a snack.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this course is to teach Professional Rescuer candidates the skills necessary to respond and give care in an emergency.

Once successfully completing this course as a certified professional rescuer, you will be able to

- Respond in an emergency
- Ensure personal & bystander safety
- Gain access to the victim
- Get consent when providing care
- Determine whether any life-threatening conditions are present
- Provide needed care for the victim
- Summon more help when needed
- Use techniques acquired from your training in the course

Technical skills include

- Primary / Secondary assessment skills
- Rescue breathing (Adult/Child/Infant)
- 2 Person -Rescue breathing w/use of bag valve
- Obstructed Airway (Conscious & Unconscious - Adult/Child/Infant)
- One Rescuer CPR (Adult/Child/Infant)
- Two Rescuer CPR (Adult/Child/Infant)
- 1 & 2 Rescuer AED Administration

Once successfully completed this course, participants will receive a
