

# Professional Climbing Instructors Association (PCIA) Single Pitch Instructor Course & Exam

## HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT:

The PCIA Single Pitch Climbing Instructor certification is granted to an individual who completes the Base and Top Managed Climbing Instructor requirements and can demonstrate basic lead climbing skills at a 5.6 standard. It may be completed as part of the 5 day Outdoor Climbing Instructor Series or assessed at a later date.

## WHERE & WHEN:

Requirements for the Single Pitch Climbing Instructor may be fulfilled during the Top Managed Climbing Instructor course. No additional time is required. Or, instructors who are certified at the Top Managed level may elect to take their Single Pitch exam at a later time.

The exact site of the course will be determined during the PCIA Base Managed course and exam, May 16-18, 2010. If you are not enrolled in the Base Managed Course & Exam, contact the course instructor for details.

## CERTIFICATION EXAM:

Those seeking PCIA Single Pitch Instructor certification must lead a climb at the 5.6 level or above. Candidates must be able to safely and efficiently set the route up as a top rope site for a group of participants.

## COST:

No additional cost is associated for the Single Pitch course and exam for those who are enrolled in the Top Managed course and exam.
