

# Traditional Lead Climbing Clinic



**THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 21 4:00 -6:00 PM**

## PREREQUISITES:

You should arrive with experience in top rope climbing and belaying. Sport lead climbing experience is helpful.

## WHERE:

We'll meet at the Inland Climbing Wall adjacent to the Ice Rink in the Sports and Health Center.

## TRADITIONAL LEAD CLIMBING:

Traditional climbers place their own removable protection as they climb. We'll review placing and evaluating rock protection for safety. Practice racking up, mock leading in the Wall and building an anchor to bring up your second.

## EQUIPMENT:

You bring:

- harness, helmet, climbing shoes (if you have them)
- any climbing pro you have (stoppers, 'biners, etc.)

We provide:

- harness and helmet if you don't have them
- all climbing equipment, ropes, carabiners, slings, etc.
