## **WHAT TO BRING:**

- Wear clothing that is appropriate for the conditions (Check the weather) and allows freedom of movement. Clothing that insulates when wet and dries quickly is a must. Layered, synthetic or wool clothing is key to dealing with unpredictable fall conditions in the Northland. Leave the cotton at home. It could snow!
- Rain Gear
- Warm hat, gloves/mittens
- Bag lunch and water bottle

- Field guides to local birds, plants, etc
