HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT:

A fun afternoon zooming down the hill near Rock Pond to see who has built the best recycled sled. There will be laughs and fun for all.

HERE'S WHAT TO PREPARE:

You and your team will be judged in the preliminaries on creativity, function, and distance. Your sled can be elaborate or simple, but must be made primarily of recycled materials and must be able to hold all members of the team on it while going down the hill. It cannot be made of wood, metal (including staples and nails), or glass on ANY of the sled's parts. Deviation from these regulations will result in immediate disqualification and no refund will be awarded.

Suggested Materials:

- Cardboard boxes
- Pizza boxes
- Duct tape
- Glue
- Recycled plastic bottles
- Plastic bags
- Paper bags
- And so on...

If a material you use seems questionable, please ask before the competition or you run the risk of disqualification.
