## **HERE'S WHAT TO EXPECT:**

Gliding over the backs of alligators, watching dolphins herd fish, paddling among sea turtles and exotic birds, and sitting next to tailing tarpon are just a few of the extraordinary things about an Everglades kayak trip.

## **WHERE:** Everglades National Park, Florida

Everglades National Park, largest subtropical wilderness in the United States, boasts rare and endangered species. It has been designated a World Heritage Site, International Biosphere Reserve, and Wetland of International Importance, significant to all people of the world.

**WHEN:** Pick-up from the airport in Tampa Bay is on Saturday, January 10 at 3pm. Spend January 11-16 paddling during the day and camping out nights in the Everglades National Park. Drop-off at the airport is Saturday, January 17 at 10am.

**COURSE INFORMATION:** Recreational Sports Outdoor Program is teaming up with the University of South Florida to bring to you this one of a kind trip. Our friends from South Florida provide shuttle service from Tampa Bay Airport to Everglade City, all kayak and camping related food and equipment, and expert local guide service. No sea kayaking experience is needed. A combination of tandem and single sea kayaks will be used.
